Livi Bank Limited ('livi' or 'livi bank') wishes to alert customers and the general public to beware of fraudulent website links purporting to be from livi bank. livi's branding materials (including the logo, name and graphics) were appropriated in such websites without authorization.

You can also call the Hong Kong Police Force Anti-Deception Coordination Centre's Anti-Scam Helpline 18222 for assistance.

Anyone who may have disclosed personal information to or conducted transactions through the fraudulent website should immediately report the case to the Hong Kong Police Force and contact livi bank.

Livi Bank Limited declares that it has no connection with the unauthorized websites. Meanwhile, the case has been reported to the Hong Kong Monetary Authority and the Hong Kong Police Force.
